Use questions beginning with who...? what...? when...? where...? why...? Encourage children to use their imagination then ask them to write about the picture. This could be a description or it could be a story. Talk about what they want to write first and encourage the use of capital letters, full stops, 'and' to join sentences.</p> <p>You could look at a different picture each day or write about one picture for the week.</p>	<p>Log on to bug club each day and read at least one book.</p> <p>Read to the people at home with you.</p> <p>Choose a book each day to listen to from https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/shows/bedtime-stories</p> <p>Or Miss Hine's snack time stories.</p>	<p>Phonics: Practise your phase 3 and 5 phonemes every day using the Flash Cards time challenge on Phonics Play. www.phonicsplay.co.uk (free access during school closure) Choose a phoneme you need to practise and play Buried Treasure or Obb and Bob.</p> <p>Login to Purple Mash and complete the phonics activities or complete 3 pages of your phonics workbook.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> <u>Terrific trees</u> This week we will be looking at different types of tree.
