Wrap Around Care and Pre-School Arrangements:

By now we are sure that most of you will be aware that CAPE decided they were going to stop operating from our premises and, as such, they vacated the premises next door at the end of August. This was very late in the day and we can only apologise for the decision that this private provider made – it was news to us as well as yourselves.

We therefore found ourselves in the position of having no pre-school or wrap around provider right at the end of the summer holidays which was extremely difficult to manage. We are grateful to the staff who were able to offer additional hours to run our wrap around facility to enable parents to still work. We will be running our wrap around facility in the school canteen until the end of this half term. After this we are hopeful that a new provider will be able to take it over for us and run it from the next door building. You will need to book onto the club in advance (by 11pm the night before at the very latest please) via the School Money website. Many thanks for your understanding at this time, this has been yet another example of how home and school can work effectively together for the good of our Thingwall families.

There has been a lot of hard work going on behind the scenes to secure arrangements for the pre-school and wrap around as quickly as we can. We delighted to announce that we are currently working very hard with an established provider to set up a new offer for parents (including pre-school parents) and we hope to have exciting news for you in the coming week or two.
