Mrs Mitchell has taught at Thingwall since September 1990, meaning that she has taught Thingwall classes of children for the last 32 years (including some pupils who are now parents at our school)! This means that she has taught and inspired *at least* 900 pupils; that's not including all the pupils she has inspired in School Band, guitar club and recorder club. It goes without saying that we will miss Mrs Mitchell's super teaching, her organised classroom, her helpful ways and her creative direction (she has co-ordinated art and music for nearly as long as she has taught here). We are extremely thankful that she will still be staying with us to cover PPA teaching across the year groups so she will still be remaining with us for four days per week for the foreseeable future. Congratulations Mrs Mitchell, 32 years in education at the same school is quite the achievement and Thingwall has been all the richer for your outstanding teaching, exemplary subject leadership and sage knowledge as part of the school's leadership team.
